- Don't read your entire presentation. Practice enough so that you only have to refer to your notes or to the slides.

- Keep your slides simple. They should NOT contain your speech... just the HIGHLIGHTS.
- Have a logical sequence to your presentation opening, body, closing.
- Practice your presentation... not once, not twice, but several times.
